

## Our Commitment to Kent's children, young people and families who are involved in the Child Protection process:

We understand talking to a social worker or having a child protection plan is not easy and can bring extra challenges and pressures for you and your family.

Our commitment to **parents and carers** includes things we will do that will help make sure that your experience of child protection in Kent is helpful and one is which you are fully involved in.

## We will:

- tell you as soon as a decision is made to hold a child protection conference and the reasons why.
- prepare you for the Conference so you know what to expect, who will be there and what information may be shared and discussed.
- make sure the environment is welcoming and a comfortable place for you to talk.
- make sure there are not too many professionals at the Conference.
- always remember you are the expert in your story and make sure you are given time to share your views, experiences and wishes.
- explain the decisions made at Conference, so you leave the meeting knowing who is going to help you and what you are being asked to do.
- make a plan with you and decide which bits are the most important to work on first of all.
- make sure we do what we say we are going to in the plan, and we will help you to do what you 've agreed to do to.
- tell you if we are worried things are not going according to the plan and if there need to be changes what this means.
- work with you to achieve the goals in the plan and end the child protection process.
- always ask for your feedback and use this to help change the way we do things.
