Who are we?


We are Kent County Council (KCC).


Kent County Council (KCC) has asked 31ten Consulting Ltd to work with local families to find out how they have been supported by Family Hubs and Start for Life services. This will involve working with children, parents & carers of children, and pregnant people and their partners. Part of this work is to run an Awareness Survey. This will help us to understand how much local people know about the Start for Life and Family Hubs Programme and what support is available.

This project will run from February 2024 to June 2025 and the Awareness Survey will run from June 2024 – March 2025.

There is a law called Data Protection and the United Kingdom General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR). This law means we must tell you:





	Anyone seeing your information must do it confidentially. This means that they must not share it unless there is a good reason, such as if you or somebody else's safety is at risk.
	Who we share your personal information with: The provider, 31ten, will collect and keep your data safe. 31ten will share some information with KCC and other organisations we are working with, and they will publish some of the final work, but we won't include your name or any of your personal information.
	We must share personal information with the Police if we are asked to by law. We will not keep information about you for longer than it is needed.
